

"We began dating in 1997 and got married in 2003," said Gelia.


After marriage, the Redmills first settled in Madison.

Gelia enjoyed working with special needs students as an instructional aide.



"Langley is kind. She has the kindest heart and is so responsible. Griff and I joke that she's more responsible than we are. She gives 100% in everything she does. She is always so respectful. The world is going to get an amazing person when she goes off to school," said Gelia.

hloe Ruble is a standout girls golfer for Lindsay Lane Christian

Academy. Chloe picked up the sport only 5 years ago, but has made significant strides to the point where scoring in the mid-to-low 70s is a regular for her. She still finds ways to critique her game even on her hole-in-one shot during a round with her grandfather.

While Chloe has goals to improve on her game each round she plays, the next step to her ultimate LPGA dream was her desire to play for a D1 college.

However, midway through Summer, it was uncertain what the future held for the upcoming senior, despite knowing how much value she could bring to a team with her attitude, work-ethic and approach to the game.

That changed recently, however, when Chloe announced she has verbally committed to the UAB Women's Golf – a cumulation of hard work and a keen talent for self-promotion.

While the recruiting process was stressful, Chloe did not wait around hoping it would happen, but decided to do what she could to make it happen.

"The stress and the challenges of being recruited has jolted my game forward, and I am excited to see what playing in DI tournaments can do to it as well," Chloe said. "College golf is just the first step in achieving my ultimate goal of playing on the LPGA as a professional Women's Golfer. Ever since I picked up a club, I couldn't imagine not playing golf."

Chloe first met her coach at UAB, Jesse Lawley, during an Elite ID camp she attended while Lawley was the head coach of the Lipscomb Women's Golf program. Lawley was named the new coach of the Blazers on August 23, 2022, according to UAB's Athletics website. Chloe then attended UAB's camp this past June.

What set Chloe apart was not only her ability to make connections with coaches along the way, but her ability to promote herself though the use of communication.

Starting her sophomore year, according to Chloe, she would send coaches updates on her stats every few weeks or so. This not only showed her talent, but also how she was improving.

In an interview with 256 Sports Radio, Chloe talked about how she also started working with a personal trainer during the past winter, which has led to her putting on muscle and hitting the ball farther.

For someone who is always looking to improve her approach shots following her drives, her ability to hit the ball farther off the tee has made a huge difference in her game. There is also a high degree of accuracy to her drives, as Chloe says she hit every fairway during the state competition for high school.

Most importantly, her persistence through email and social media made it to where her hard work couldn't be ignored.

"At the end of the day, coaches everywhere are going to recognize someone who is putting in the time and focusing on getting better. Once you start to improve, you will not be able to go unnoticed," Chloe said, providing advice to other golfers aspiring for college.

Chloe's upcoming senior season for Lindsay Lane will provide plenty of time to improve her golf game even further. However, as a Senior leader, Chloe says she will be spending just as much time helping her teammates improve their own game through practicing the right way and being mentally tough.
